We practice and believe that all preparations **MUST** be completed on the entire exterior before we put a
Please keep in mind that all exterior projects require different levels of preparations and different coating

Proper and thorough exterior preparation is critical simply because of its exposure to weather and outdo

Pressure washing is the first step in preparing an exterior for painting. In 99% of cases an exterior shoul

The next step in preparing your exterior for paint is removing all failing caulking and any remaining loose
Any metal surfaces such as steel lintels and wrought iron will require special preparation, if they are rust
All exterior hardware, i.e., light fixtures, outdoor furniture, as well as plants are either moved or covered.

Once preparation is complete, a preparation inspection is performed before any finish coat painting begins. Progressive Painting traditionally uses the brush and roll method for exterior and interior painting. We are
